It was so lovely to see so many parents attending our Parents' Meetings this week and as always being really supportive. It is really important that everyone has paid their deposit of £50 by the end of September as the next payment will need to be made by October. I really don't want to be a position of having to chase parents for payments as this is really time consuming. Please remember that this trip is compulsory, it is part of their curriculum and as a school we have to provide such learning experiences.

Just in case you didn't see the newsletter last week, please take the time to look at our Ofsted Report which has now been published on the Ofsted website which can be accessed on: Ofsted UK reports, click on find inspection report and type in the school name. We are extremely proud of what as a school we have all achieved together and it is so important to celebrate this.

I am delighted to report that our overall attendance this week is 98.1% which is above our target of 97%. Please really make every effort to maintain this now.

Thank you to those parents who have made the effort to donate tissues for their child's class. This is really appreciated and is supporting us as a school in these challenging financial times.

On the subject of the school budget, I am very concerned about the large number of parents who have yet to pay their annual governors' maintenance of £35 for 2016/17. It is important to note that this money goes towards all the fantastic building work that we have had completed at our school over the years. Without this fund we would never have been able to afford this work that has really benefitted the pupils. Therefore, it is very important that all parents continue to pay this annual contribution as any outstanding balance has to be paid by the school and this means that other areas will have to be cut back for example visits from poets, trips being subsidised.
