

## **Enrichment activities**

**String Orchestra:** One pupil from St John's in the past has been part of a String Orchestra run by Enfield Music Service .

**Organ Recital:** The pupils in Yr.5/6 have participated in an organ recital in St. Luke's Church, followed by a workshop on how the organ works.

**Science Project Science Project for Yr.5/6:** For several years now, we have worked with other schools in the ETSP group on a science project which involves the pupils using the science laboratory in Chase Community School to carry out a series of different experiments. In July they will come together as a group and present their findings.

**School Trip:** Every year pupils in Emerald Class (Yr.5/6) visit either St. Paul's Cathedral or Westminster Abbey. This year they will be visiting St. Pauls and in the past this trip has been led by the vicar, previously Father Edward and Father Peter.

**Annual Trips:** Alternate years our Yr.5/6 pupils have a residential at an activity centre in Shropshire in the Summer Term and all of KS2 go on a day trip to France with Madame Sylvie our French Teacher and the KS2 staff. The next trip is to Shropshire on the 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2022 for Years 5/6. Every year both Ruby and Sapphire class have a trip to the Discover Centre in Stratford where they participate in a day of story telling and a variety of interactive literacy activities. **The School Choir:** The School Choir which is open to pupils from Yr. 2 – Yr.6 meets every Wednesday from 3pm - 4pm led by our Music Teacher, Mrs. Miller. The choir participates in all the church services and concerts. We also represented the school at two Borough music festivals which were held at Carterhatch School.

**Enfield Town School Partnership:** The School has participated in two poetry festivals and an art exhibition. This year we are participating in an art project with an art exhibition in the Summer Term. In the past we have participated in: maths quizzes, debating, public speaking, spelling bee competition and general knowledge quizzes. Our school spelling bee champions took part in a competition with other schools in the Enfield Town Schools Partnership in the Autumn Term. The children represented our school very well and really enjoyed trying to spell some tricky words!
