Late Collection Policy

Policy aim:

To enable staff to attend training, meetings and carry out essential marking and lesson preparation after school **by** ensuring **timely** collection of children.

From **April 2016** the Governors have imposed a late collection charge for children who are not collected from school on time.

The late collection policy will operate to the following timetable from the end of the school day:

- School finishes at 3.00pm
- Teachers will remain in the classroom until 3.05pm
- At 3.05pm children will be taken to the office by the class teacher for collection and supervised by a member of the office staff
- At 3.10pm teacher training sessions and meetings begin
- From 3.10pm a charge will be payable for each child remaining in the office.

Whenever a child is collected late there will always be at least two members of staff on site.

Costings:

- On the first occasion when a child is not collected by 3.10pm, you will be charged a one-off payment of £3 per child.
- For every subsequent time when a child is not collected by 3.10pm, you will be charged £3.00 per 10 minutes, per child. For example, if you pick up your child at 3.50pm, you are 40 minutes late and this will cost you £12.00 per child.
- For After School Clubs which finish at 4.00pm, if a child is not collected by 4.05pm, you will be charged £3.00 per 10 minutes, per child. For example, if you pick up your child at 4.15pm, you are 10 minutes late and this will cost you £3.00 per child.
- The office clock will be used to determine the cost.

There will also be a charge if parents phone the school to say they are running late but children are still not collected by 3.10pm.
