### Reading:

Every child is in a reading group reading the same text. They will be set reading each guided reading lesson to be ready for their next guided reading sessions on a Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Comprehension style questions will be set on a regular basis to check their understanding of the text and ensure they are on track. This will be in an orange exercise book.

#### **Timestables:**

Each child has an account on Timestables Rock Stars which will help them to learn and become quicker on their timestables. Your child will receive their login details this week and for those children that are still developing this, it would be great to practice on a regular basis. We have a timestables speed test every Thursday morning and also use Nintendo DS machines to practice mental maths.

# **Mental Maths Books/Maths Homework:**

Every child should have a mental maths book and complete one page on a weekly basis to be handed in no later than Wednesday each week. Any questions that they find difficult give them a go but also let me know so that I can go over it with them. Each child will also have a MyMaths account and homework will be set on a Friday evening to be completed online by Thursday morning.

# **Spellings**

We have a weekly spelling test on a Wednesday morning. Children will receive their spellings each week to learn at home. They will also have time first thing every morning to complete their look, cover, spell activity.

## **Behaviour**

We use a basic behaviour system where every child starts the day on green. If they display good behaviour for the whole day then they will stay on green and be rewarded with a treat decided by them. If children do make mistakes they will be reminded of the appropriate behaviour but may move down to yellow if they persist. Further steps are orange and red which are for persistent defiance and serious incidents. The huge majority of children tend to stay on green each day, although we have added in a new shining like stars section-for real stars!!

Full school uniform is to be worn on a daily basis apart from our PE days which is a Tuesday, Thursday and a Friday and also any days where they attend a club. Clubs for Emerald class children are as follows:
