

St. John's C.E. Primary School – Uniform Guide



Nursery

Our Nursery children may wear either the standard school uniform (see below) or a more practical option to support independence and self-care:

- White polo shirt with logo
- Royal blue school sweatshirt with logo
- Royal blue jogging bottoms
- Slip-on or Velcro trainers (no laces please)

This option makes it easier for little ones to manage toileting and change quickly for outdoor play.

P.E. Kit (All Year Groups)

- White polo shirt with logo
- Royal blue cotton shorts OR
- Black tracksuit bottoms
- Black tracksuit zip-up with logo
- Trainers or plimsolls
- School PE bag with logo

On PE days, children wear their PE kit to school.

Jewellery must be removed for safety (small stud earrings only, to be taken out or covered).

Accessories & Presentation

- Long hair must be tied back; hair bands and clips should be royal blue, black or white.
- No nail polish or make-up.
- Coats, hats, scarves and gloves should be in dark, neutral colours.
- All clothing, footwear and bags must be clearly labelled with your child's name.
- Lost property is kept until the end of term before being recycled or donated.

Book Bags & Water Bottles

- Reception and Key Stage 1 pupils must have a book bag with the school logo.
- All pupils must bring a named water bottle each day.

- All items must be clearly named.
